French television documentary. Includes footage of: Fretilin guerillas, Indonesian soldiers in training. Photos corpses and prisoners in 1975-78. Refugee families in slums near Lisbon. Families of Timorese Resistance in the mountains. Nicolau Lobato, leader of Fretilin, in his coffin filled with ice. A prison almost deserted. Int. Red Cross physician in a village on the south coast. Distribution of food and medicines. Group of para military youth. Int. The Chief of Scouts. The Indonesian flag raising in each school children reciting the 5 principles. Omnipresence of the military in every village. Directed to the team of journalists: the army helping the people in the field work. General Suharto. An animist ceremony. Dili, a small town serving as a showcase for foreigners: street cleaned, TV stations or programs are broadcast by satellite to Jakarta. Also includes footage of French-language interviews with the much younger Jose Luis Guterres and Abilio Araujo
