- 1) Arrange a public meeting for them on Saturday Nov. 30 or Sunday December 1. Horta will write to you giving the name of other FRETILIN leader coming. It would be excellent if you could advertise the public meeting widely, through the name maybe of a committee (we call ourselves the Campaign for Independent East Timor), which maybe could be formalised at the public meeting. Horta will also send you names of Timorese living in Darwin you could especially invite.
 - 2) Arrange accomodation for the two of them, and for media interviews etc..
 - 3) They will, I hope, have return air tickets with them. The part from Darwin return will be open. I will have booked their entire flight from Darwin and back, but will need you to see that the booked flights are entered on their tickets. I'll write later giving you details.
 - 4) They'll probably return to Darwin about 15 December 17, but that is not certain.
 - 5) Maybe Wes could have a discussion at some length about aid to the co-operatives, or maybe could organise such a discussion with some in that field in Darwin who might be interested?
